With the health and safety of our clients and all concerned, we are committed to make sure that our workshops meet the <u>CDC travel protocols</u> Every location where we offer trips will be different and precautions will be taken to lower any coronavirus exposure. However, when we choose to travel, we must acknowledge the risk of contact to disease—COVID-19 or otherwise.

Some of the protocols we will implement on our workshops:

- For carpooling, we will ensure as much spacing as possible in our vehicles and make sure that everyone sits next to a window as allowing extra room to breathe is important. We will make sure that there is one space between quests per seat row whenever possible.
- For those that are not comfortable riding in another vehicle, we will ensure various daily locations will have enough parking to allow participants to drive their own vehicles if desired.
- As long as Covid 19 is a factor, in states and locations that mandate face masks, face masks will be required for all members of the group when indoors, in vehicles or when physical distancing of six feet or more between people is not possible.
- Guests will be encouraged to bring their own travel-sized hand sanitizer and apply regularly throughout the day. We will provide supplies if necessary.
- As leaders, we are familiar with the COVID-19 protocols as it pertains to our workshops and what steps to take if an attendee begins to demonstrate symptoms while with us.
- Vehicles will be sanitized at the end of each day. We also ask that other vehicles that may be involved with carpooling to be sanitized as well. We will provide the proper supplies to do so.
- Attendees will be asked to not handle photo gear that is not their own. However, as leaders will be there to assist as always.
